Adam Series Mantels, designed by the Adam brothers of England in the eighteenth century, are characterized by the use of highly decorated scrolls, frets, festoons, bows and swags. Pilasters are enhanced with delicate reeded and fluted mouldings that have complimenting plinth and capital blocks. Bold crown mouldings accented with or without dentil.

Federal Series Mantels

The federal style is the dominant phase of formal neoclassic architecture in the United States. This style evolved out of the popularity of Georgian architecture during the late 1700's. Characteristics of this style include delicate mouldings, slender - tapered columns, framed oval capitals, and distinctive crown moulding arrangements.

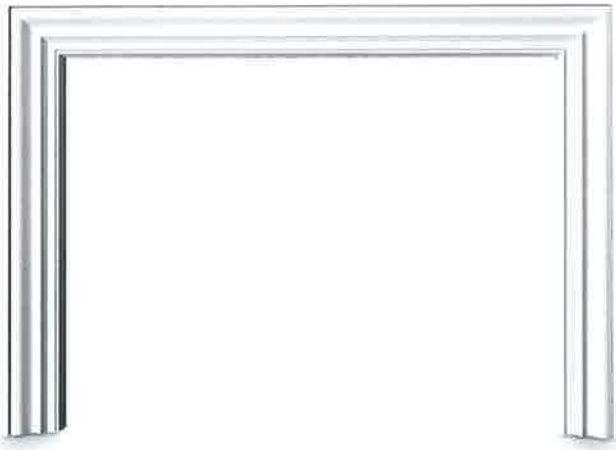

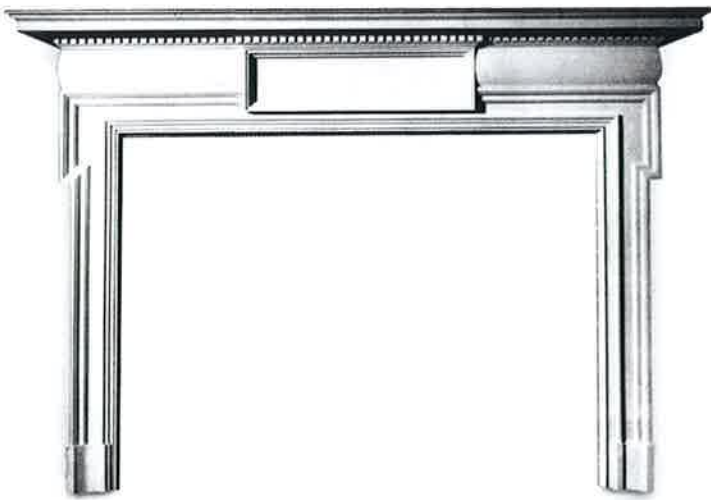

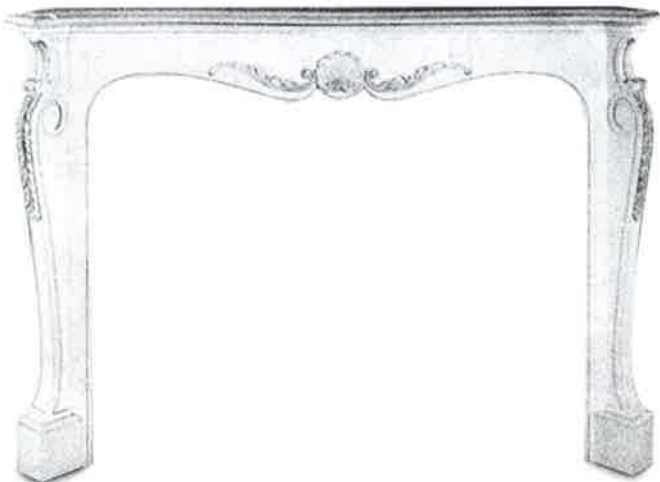
